(Yearbook 1: planning and layout)
(July 2017)

Unit Statement: The student will participate in creating the school yearbook, which reflects the history of the school year. This is a project-based unit in which the student will work as part of a team on certain aspects of the yearbook. Selective unit 9 (Yearbook 1) focuses on planning and layout. The student will work as part of a team to plan the ladder, the tool that provides students and staff with the structure needed to successfully complete a yearbook project.

Essential Outcomes: (must be assessed for mastery)

1. **The Student Will** work cooperatively with a team of students.
2. **TSW** plan the ladder to identify content, record deadlines, note editors and reporters responsible for content.
3. **TSW** show the yearbook's responsibility in publication: include everyone at the school, fairness, accuracy, and good taste.
4. **TSW** design layout using grid methods.
5. **TSW** edit photos using Adobe Photoshop (or equivalent program).
6. **TSW** adhere to deadlines.

Suggested Materials/Software:

Adobe Creative Suite CS6: InDesign, Photoshop
Microsoft Publisher

Suggested Websites & Activities:

1. Include articles describing events of the past year. Use photos that show the events.
2. Many ideas can be found online, have students research ideas before picking a theme.
